

Certification of Incorporated Political Committee [CRO-3700]

Form Description

This certification is used by a political committee that incorporates for legal purposes.

By filing this certification, the treasurer indicates that the NC State Board of Elections & Ethics Enforcement has received the Articles of Incorporation for the above-named committee. As required by NCGS§163-278.19(g), the committee's purpose is to accept contributions and make expenditures to influence elections as a political committee only. Therefore, the committee is certified and able to conduct business as a political committee.

If at any time the purpose of the committee is changed and/or the Article of Incorporation amended, this certification is void until such time the changes have been approved by the NC State Board of Elections & Ethics Enforcement.

Line-by-Line Instructions

Committee Name. Provide the full name of the committee.

Treasurer Name. Provide the full name of the treasurer.

Treasurer Address. Provide the address (including city, state and zip code) for the treasurer of the committee.

Treasurer Phone. Provide the phone number (including area code) for the treasurer of the committee.
