

# ELECTION DAY VOTER CHALLENGE

## PRECINCT OFFICIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Verify that the person making the challenge meets the Challenger requirements.
- Call the Board of Elections before proceeding.

## CHALLENGER REQUIREMENTS

- The Challenger must be a registered voter in \_\_\_\_\_ County.
- The Challenger may enter the voting enclosure only for the purpose of making a challenge (unless registered in the precinct and in the process of voting).
- Challenger must leave the voting enclosure after the challenge is heard.

- Has already voted in this election (if a vote for a specific election is being challenged) GS 163-87(2)
- Is a registered voter of a different political party (if participating in a partisan primary) GS 163-87(4)
- Is not qualified to vote an absentee ballot (which would include one-stop absentee voting) GS 163-89
- Has not provided acceptable photo identification GS 163-87(5)

\*If the voter was referred to a voting site's judges of elections for a determination of reasonable resemblance of photo ID and the judges make a determination, that determination may also control any challenge made alleging that the person attempting to vote isn't who he or she represents himself or herself to be. See NCGS 163-166.14(c)
