More information about the “No-Fee Voter ID Card”

Any voter who does not have a photo identification that is acceptable for purposes of voting can obtain an identification card issued by the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles at no cost (**No-Fee Voter ID Card**). GS § 163-166.13. To obtain a No-Fee Voter ID Card, you must sign a declaration stating that you do not have an acceptable photo ID. If you already have an acceptable photo ID, you are not eligible to receive a No-Fee Voter ID Card. You must also provide the following information:

Proof of Age & Identity

- You must provide two documents which provide your full name and date of birth. If you are unable to provide two forms of identification, the DMV will review documents that you have in your possession to assist in verifying your identity. Please visit www.ncsbe.gov or www.ncdot.gov/dmv to see a list of acceptable documents.

Valid Social Security Number

- You must provide a valid Social Security Number (SSN). If the DMV is unable to verify your SSN with the Social Security Administration, you may be required to present documentation of your SSN.

Proof of Citizenship & Residency

- To obtain a NC Voter ID Card, you must be a U.S. citizen and a N.C. resident.

When your application is accepted, you will be provided with a receipt upon request. Your receipt cannot be used for identification or voting purposes. Your No-Fee Voter ID card will be mailed to you. It may take up to 10 days for you to receive your card.
